Grant program for student and faculty exchanges between U.S. colleges and German vocational schools



#### **Our Grant Program**



German Apprenticeship Training Exchange (GATE) is a grant program by the Joachim Herz Foundation (JHF). It supports transatlantic vocational exchanges between U.S. colleges and German vocational schools.

- It is open to U.S. Colleges and German vocational schools and can include an initial faculty delegation visit and students exchanges
- Faculty may accompany the students (ratio of 1:5)
- Exchange programs can include job shadowing, company tours, participation in college courses, and cultural activities

### What can be covered by the grant

- Return flights between USA and Germany
- Accommodation
- Meals
- Transportation (car rental, bus, train)
- Entry costs for exhibitions, museums etc.
- Visa fees









### Grant program guidelines

- The application for GATE grants must be submitted by the German vocational school, which will receive the funds
- Depending on mutual agreements, grants can be used to cover the travel expenses for both partner institutions
- GATE grants can be combined with other U.S. or German funding (public/private)
- The GATE program encourages long-term and impact-oriented exchange projects



### Possible roadmap for exchanges

- First application: Delegation visit (Faculty)
- Following three applications: **Visits with students** and faculty to the USA or Germany (Ratio of one teacher for 5 students). Possible activities include:
  - Participation in college courses, job shadowing at companies, online meetings prior to visits
  - Company visits, cultural tours and activities
  - Collaborative projects between U.S. students and German apprentices
